

NOTICE TO RESIDENTS
CITY OF MOUNT CLEMENS

COMPOSTING PROGRAM SCHEDULED TO BEGIN THE WEEK OF MARCH 30, 2009

A special yard waste collection truck will begin operating in the City beginning March 30, 2009 through December 4, 2009.

BEGINNING MARCH 30, 2009, please do one of the three following things to eliminate yard waste:

- Compost your yard waste at home.
- Place your yard waste loose in a 25- to 35-gallon refuse container labeled “yard waste” or “compost”.
- Place yard waste in a 30-gallon brown paper leaf bag. The City will continue to sell leaf bags at City Hall located at One Crocker Boulevard and the Department of Public Services located at 95 Eldredge.

Brush and branches less than 3” in diameter must be cut into four (4) foot lengths and tied into bundles that are less than 18” in diameter. Bundles should also be less than 50 pounds. Branches that are more than 3” in diameter, logs, stumps, or roots cannot be picked up by the contractor. Please call the Department of Public Services for disposal information of these items.

Yard waste can be placed at the curb for collection with your household refuse by 7 a.m. on your regular pick-up day.
